

Mr Ahmed R Ahmed PhD FRCS – Consultant Bariatric Surgeon

Mr Ahmed is a consultant in upper gastrointestinal surgery and lead bariatric surgeon at Imperial weight centre. He was elected to the Council of the British Obesity and Metabolic Surgery Society (BOMSS) in 2018 and to the Council of the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2020.

Mr Ahmed has performed over 7,000 laparoscopic bariatric procedures, including over 4000 gastric bypasses. His main areas of interest are in complex revisional bariatric surgeries and he receives referrals from all over the UK and abroad for his expert skills.

He has trained in general and upper GI surgery in the UK and at Stanford University and the University of Rochester in the US. He trains other surgeons in the field of bariatric surgery and is on the faculty on numerous courses on bariatric surgery. Mr Ahmed is often consulted by other professionals and medicolegal experts for his opinions on complex bariatric surgery cases. He is also actively involved in bariatric surgery research having undertaken a PhD degree in mechanisms of complications of gastric bypass surgery at Imperial College London. He is a clinical senior lecturer at Imperial College London and has numerous publications in peer reviewed journals. Mr Ahmed's Imperial Weight Centre bariatric surgery unit in London has been designated as an International Centre of Excellence for bariatric surgery.
