

Mr Stewart Tucker – Panellist



Stewart Tucker is senior spinal surgeon at Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children NHS Trust. He has been a Consultant Surgeon for 22 years and was originally appointed to the Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, where he worked for 16 years. He has worked at GOSH for 12 years, and has served as Head of Clinical Services and Clinical Lead.

Mr Tucker specialises in the surgical management of complex paediatric spinal deformities, including scoliosis and kyphosis, growing rod technology, spondylolisthesis and spinal tumours. He also has an interest in the management of adolescent back pain.

Mr Tucker is widely published in peer reviewed journals. He is a co-designer of the Nuvasive Reline Pedicle Screw System and pioneered the Reline 3D Tower method of scoliosis correction that is now being endorsed worldwide. He has lectured and presented clinically-based research at numerous international conferences. He is founder of the Passionate About Spine Conferences, that have attracted distinguished speakers from the world of spinal surgery.
